



SCHOOL MUSIC LESSONS

I am pleased to announce that The Absolute Music Trust will be delivering music lessons at your child's school, starting in the Spring 2026 Term.

Absolute Music was set-up in 2003 and runs a music superstore and studio complex in Bournemouth. In 2017 we created our own charity (The Absolute Music Trust) to support music in local schools and to enrich lives in the local community through music. Our tutors are all experienced musicians who are passionate about music and highly enthusiastic to open up the exciting world of music to young people.

We will be providing tuition on drums, piano, vocals and guitar. Lessons are 20 minutes long with 2 pupils at a time and will take place during the school day. The lessons cost £7.00 each and we aim to deliver 10 lessons per term, starting from the second week of term.

1:1 lessons are available and will be £14 each per session.

Drums and piano will be available for your child to use in the lessons, but it is preferable to bring their own guitar to school. Your child should have access to an instrument at home.

STANDARD AGREEMENT FOR MUSIC TUITION BY PERIPATETIC MUSIC TEACHERS

LESSONS of 20 minutes duration will be given weekly during term time, with 2 students in each lesson. Students will receive approximately 10 lessons per term, to total 30 lessons in the academic year. If we are unable to match a student with a suitable pairing then we will deliver a 10 minute 1 to 1 lesson.

MISSED LESSONS It is the pupil/school's responsibility to ensure that they attend the music lessons at the correct time each week. Lessons missed through the teacher's absence will be made up or credited. Unfortunately, lessons missed through a student's occasional absence cannot be made up or credited. In the case of a sports day or school trip that affects the majority of children, we will do our best to reschedule the lesson provided the school gives us plenty of notice.

FEES will be payable termly in advance and should be paid by the due date stated. If you are unable to pay the full amount in one go then please contact us so we can discuss a payment plan. Students will be automatically re-enrolled for lessons at the start of each subsequent term to guarantee their place. You can cancel at the end of any term by emailing lessons@absolutemusictrust.org

INSTRUMENTS Students should provide their own instruments where these are portable i.e. guitar/recorder. If this is not possible please let us know so we can ensure an instrument is available. Pianos and drums will be provided for lessons at school and it is preferable for your child to have access to an instrument for practice at home.

COMMUNICATION All students will be given a diary when starting the lessons to provide a record of their progress and a line of communication between the tutor and parent / carer. Outside lesson times, communication between students and peripatetic music teachers will be via the Education Coordinator. Students may not text or telephone the music teachers or use personal email addresses.
