
# Written Subtraction 'Numberline'


Start by putting the numbers on the numberline, smallest to largest

267 736


Now mark on the 'landing points' along the line

Add the jumps.




#### £20 - £6.24


We can use the same method to subtract using money.

Now mark on the 'landing points' along the line




Calculate how far each 'jump' is



Add the jumps.

Read these in this direction as one amount £13 and 70p and 6p = £13.76



£20 - £6.24 = £13.76
